Layton has adopted or enhanced policies around mitigation, staffing, and materials/supplies as outlined below.



Work areas, tools, and equipment are cleaned in accordance with CDC and local health department guidance on a regular basis.



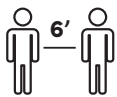
Proper signage has been installed alerting all workers to prioritize hand hygiene is visible at all jobsite entrances.



Mandatory face coverings are to be worn at all times.



Daily health screening question checklist of all workers on each project during daily meeting.



Workers are discouraged from gathering or socializing, unless they're following the recommended social distancing measures.



In-person meetings have been reduced to the extent possible. If in-person meetings are necessary, workers should maintain the recommended separation from each other.



All relevant personnel are encouraged to report for work as long as they have not become infected and the jobsite remains open; high-risk individuals will consider their own circumstances



Visitors to the jobsite are strictly limited to essential personnel.



The appropriate Layton resource will maintain regular contact with materials suppliers to identify early signs of potential supplier disruptions.



Trade partners have been instructed to develop labor and supplier contingency plans to minimize potential disruptions.
